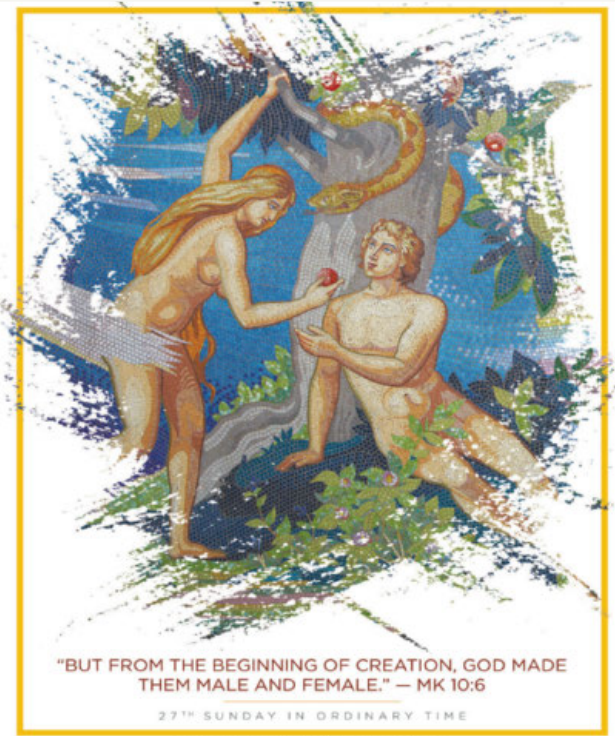

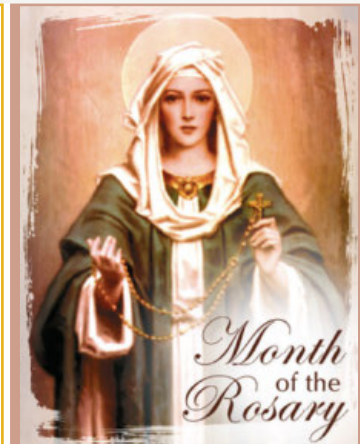

### *Gospel Meditation*

October 6, 2024  
27th Sunday in Ordinary Time

As a young pastor years ago, I met with a middle-aged couple who had been divorced and civilly remarried. They were frustrated that an annulment had to precede a Church marriage. Sympathizing with their plight, I promised to walk with them along their journey. Once as we sat in my office, the man said to me, "Why is the Church so difficult on marriage?" I replied, "Actually, Jesus' teaching is what's difficult." He furrowed his brow and asked what I meant.

We opened the Bible and together read today's gospel passage from Mark 10:12 in which Jesus says, "Whoever divorces his wife and marries another, commits adultery with her..." My two friends sat in silent astonishment. Surely Jesus understands the complexities of human life and sexual love. The words hung thick and heavy in the air. How could the merciful Lord be so seemingly unrealistic in his expectations, especially with so much divorce and remarriage in our world?

I didn't know what to say. So, we kept reading. Next, Jesus says, "Let the children come to me." The innocence of children allows them to receive and give love, to trust unconditionally, to believe in love that endures. Most children aren't yet jaded by statistics, broken hearts, or dysfunctional relationships. Children remind us of the world to come. The couple and I began to talk about child-like trust in Jesus and his teaching, and we continued to move forward. When it comes to the Church's demanding teaching on marriage, it's best to approach it as trusting children, whatever situations in which we find ourselves.

## *From the Heart of a Priest* by Fr. Timothy Dogo

### **MEMBERS OF THE CONSECRATED LIFE (MCL) OR RELIGIOUS LIFE**

#### *The Evangelical Counsels*

The members of the consecrated life answer God's invitation "to come, follow me," when they join any of the religious institutes or congregations. After the candidates undergo the different stages of formation, they move forward to the perpetual profession, which qualifies the members of the consecrated life to full membership into their chosen religious institute. Candidates voluntarily accept to consecrate themselves through the profession of the Evangelical Counsels, namely: chastity, poverty, and obedience. The perpetual profession is comparable to St. Paul's analogy of Christian marriage where he urges: "Husbands, love your wives just as Christ loved the Church and gave his life for it." (Eph 5:25) The religious commitment is comparable to that of Christ and the Church. Jesus becomes the spouse that the religious make a wholehearted commitment to. Single-mindedly they submit themselves to the service of God and His people.

Canon Law unequivocally states: "Consecrated life through the profession of evangelical counsels is a stable form of living in which the faithful follow Christ more closely under the action of the Holy Spirit, and are dedicated to God, who is supremely loved...they are dedicated to seek the perfection of charity in the service of God's Kingdom, for the honor of God, the building up of the Church and the salvation of the world. They are a splendid sign in the Church, as they foretell the heavenly glory" (Can 573). It is important to note that the vocation to religious life comes through the Holy Spirit, a call to imitate and exemplify the lifestyle of Christ by living their consecrated life within the religious institutes canonically established by a competent ecclesiastical authority.

The evangelical counsels of poverty, chastity, and obedience – hold profound significance for individuals in religious life because this guides their spiritual journey and shapes their commitment to God and service to humanity. Moreover, the evangelical counsels are deeply rooted in the phenomenal teachings of Jesus in the Sermon of the Mount known as the beatitudes. This variety of lessons offers a framework for living out the Christian vocation in a radical way. This is the type of lifestyle that Jesus championed and put forward not only to the religious but to all believers. The evangelical counsels are simply the summary of the beatitudes.

Indeed, the evangelical counsels are means by which the consecrated persons present or proclaim Jesus Christ to the world. By their life, the consecrated persons constantly demonstrate to the world that to live like Jesus is not a task that is impossible to accomplish. Guided by the three evangelical counsels, the members of the consecrated life passionately involve themselves in establishing Christ's kingdom on earth. They try to exercise their God-given role of loving all without any reservation, sharing things with others without conditions, and obeying the just demands of all without any trace of superiority. Thus, it suffices to examine the evangelical counsels one after the other.

#### *Evangelical Counsel of Chastity*

The evangelical counsel of chastity embraced for the sake of the Kingdom of heaven is a sign of the world to come, and a source of greater fruitfulness in an undivided heart (Can 599). Chastity is one of the vows that religious men and women affirm during their permanent profession. This reflects a commitment to purity of heart and dedication of oneself entirely to God. This presupposes renouncing romantic relationships and family life, to creating profound opportunities for a deeper union with Christ. Chastity enables members of consecrated life to detach from marital relationships to attach to God, and foster an atmosphere of openness and availability to their commitment, and render undivided service to God. The theology of chastity is for the sake of the kingdom of heaven (Mt 19:22) that the members of the consecrated life profess and esteem as an exceptional gift that calls for moderation and self-discipline in sexual matters. Indeed, religious men and women take the vow of chastity when Christ proposed the chaste life to married and the unmarried in the beatitude: "*Blessed are the pure of heart, for they shall see God.*" (Mt 5:8)
