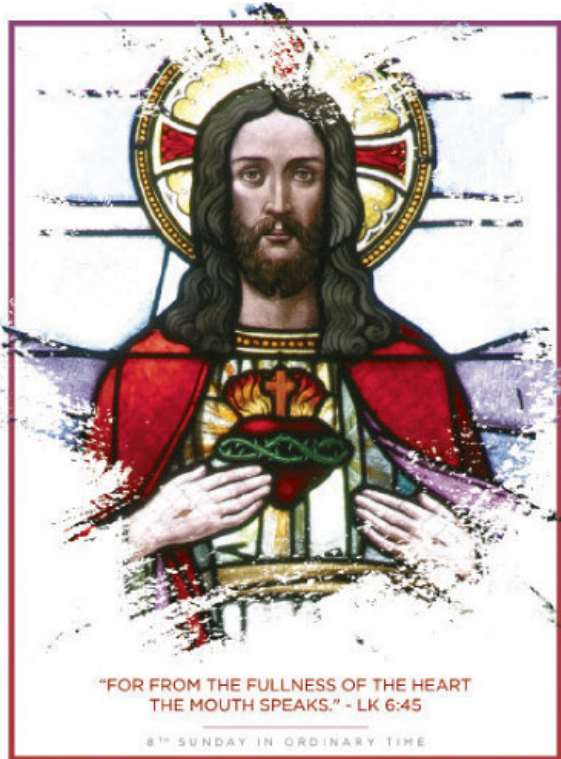

Gospel Meditation

March 2, 2025
8th Sunday of Ordinary Time
Luke 6:39-45

One of the things that older pastors and younger priests occasionally quarrel about is the proper balance between work and prayer. I know one pastor who complains that his younger associate ignores the people and the parish because he wants to spend more time in prayer. And the young priest complains that the pastor gives him too much work to do and no time to pray. The Lord's words this Sunday speak into this tension with an image that can help us find a proper balance between life and prayer.

Jesus says, "For every tree is known by its fruit. For people do not pick figs from thorn bushes, nor do they gather grapes from brambles" (Luke 6:44). When we are deeply rooted and cultivating our relationship with Jesus, we are going to bear the fruit of that love in our lives. No fruit, no good prayer. How do we know that we are praying well? We are experiencing concrete fruits of love for others in our lives.

Someone who prays well will, sooner or later, burst forth the "figs" and "grapes" of acts of love. But without concrete commitment to deeds of selfless service to others, our prayer time is as useless as thorn bushes and brambles. Let's recommit ourselves to be men and women of prayer and service. And hopefully the pastors will help their associates to pray and serve fruitfully...with minimal quarreling.

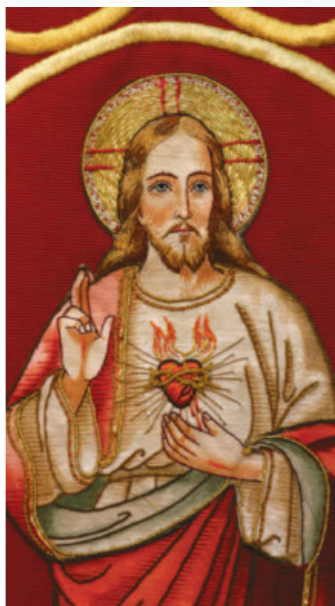

LENT

prayer. fasting. almsgiving.

Lent is an invitation to enter the desert with Christ. Through prayer, fasting, abstinence & almsgiving we find our hunger for God as we prepare for Easter.

PRAYER:

A conversation with God, forming a deeper intimacy in relationship with God, a way to learn to hear His plan for us. Renew and rededicate our prayer life:

- Pray each time you are aware of what you are abstaining from
- Pray the Stations of the Cross: on Fridays at 5:30 in the church, or on your own
- Meditate on Holy Scripture with Lectio Divina
- Reflect more deeply during Mass, paying particular attention to the Eucharistic prayer
- Pray with your children or as a family
- Start a practice of daily prayer with the intention of keeping it long after Lent

FASTING:

A spiritual practice where we voluntarily eat less as an act of devotion, penance & self-discipline. An imitation of Christ's 40 days of fasting in the desert to focus on prayer & dependence on God.

Catholics age 18-59 fast on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday

- 1 full meal & 2 smaller meals (not equal to the full meal)
 - No snacks between meals, liquids are allowed
- Fasting imitates Christ's example, is an act of penance, cultivates detachment from worldly goods, strengthens virtue & discipline, deepens prayer & almsgiving.

ABSTINENCE:

A practice of refraining from eating meat as a form of penance & spiritual discipline. This allows us to grow in self-control, detach from material comforts & unites us to Christ's suffering.

Catholics 14+ abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays during Lent. Fish is permitted.

Abstinence from meat is an act of penance, honoring Christ's sacrifice on the cross.

ALMSGIVING:

A practice of prayer and fasting by sacrificially & mercifully giving away material things, serving others and placing faith in God that His will be done. This can be done through the Corporal Works of Mercy:

feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, shelter the homeless, visit the sick, visit the imprisoned, bury the dead, give to the poor.

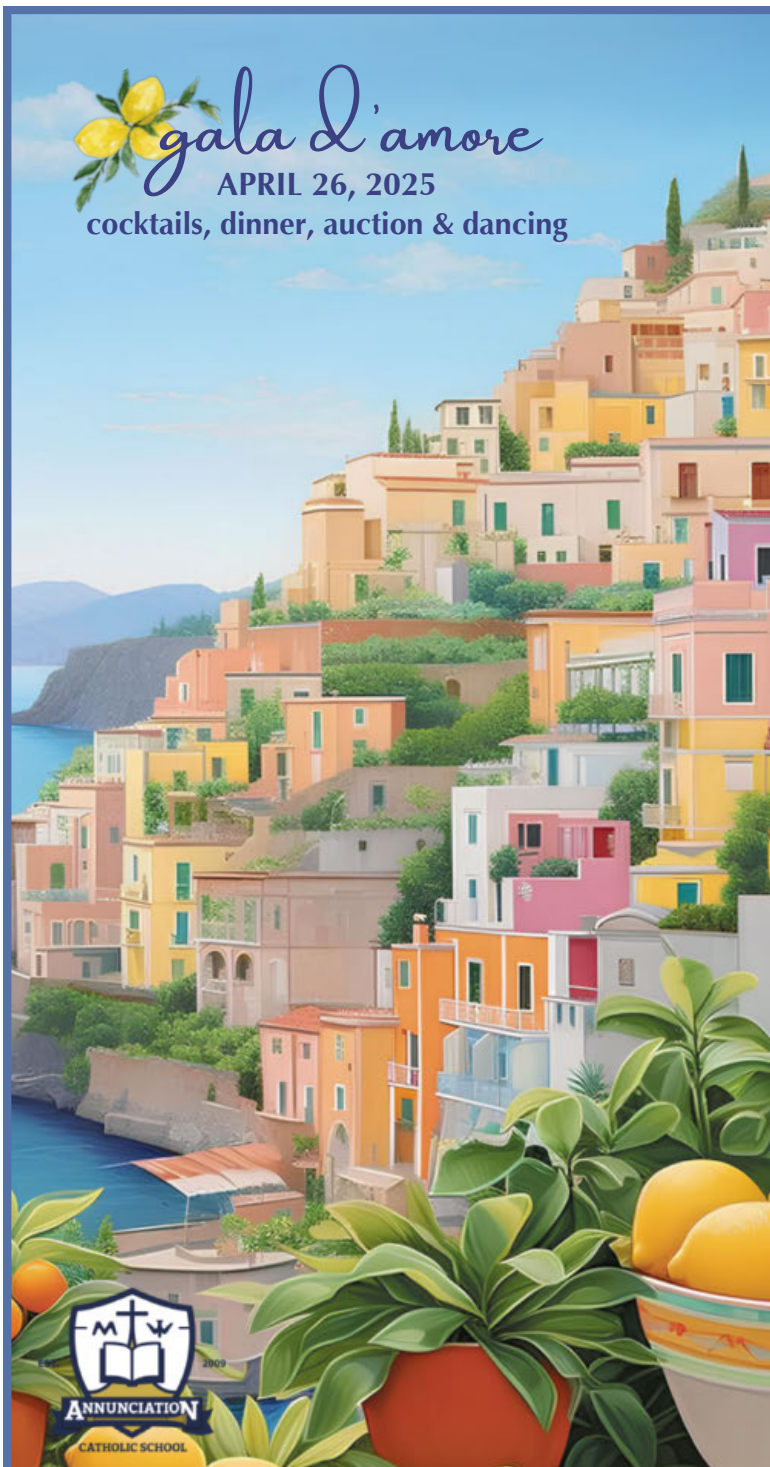
