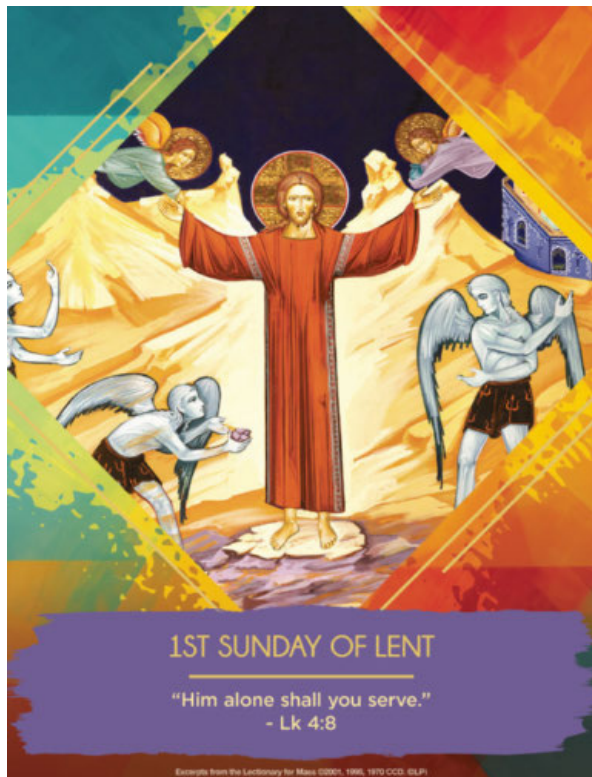

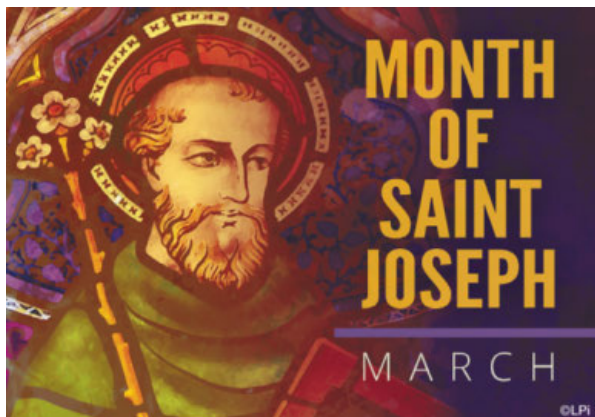

# DISCOVER TRUE GREATNESS



## *Gospel Meditation*

March 9, 2025  
1st Sunday of Lent  
Luke 4:1-13

One of the most fascinating moments in American history is when George Washington could have become the king of the newly liberated United States and didn't. At the height of his power and fame, on Dec. 23, 1783, he resigned his commission as Commander-in-Chief, and went home. The astonished King of England remarked that in doing so, Washington was "the greatest man in the world." Greatness is often defined by what we could do but don't. Greatness is measured by the temptations we overcome.

Jesus' greatness is revealed in his victory over temptations, too. The three offered him by the devil contain, we might say, all potential possible temptations: food, power and fame. They correspond to the triple human needs of body, soul and spirit. In overcoming these three, he says "no" in essence to every and even the greatest temptation. We see that every desire of his humanity – body, soul and spirit – is perfectly united to God, to love. This is a power available to each member of his body. It is the path to true greatness. How can we, who so easily fall into even small temptations, find the power to overcome large ones? By entering into the great dynamics of Jesus' temptations.

Lenten challenge: This first week of Lent, list some concrete ways you can overcome temptations that correspond with your desires. For example, you may give up snacks between meals, choose not to participate in an activity of which you are an expert, and decide to reduce social media posting by 50%. It may not seem like much, but by saying "no" to the tyranny of food, power, and fame (in this example), you'll discover true greatness.

## *From the Pastor's Desk*

Thank you to the 78 families (as of writing this) who have given so far to the annual Diocesan Charity and Development Appeal (CDA).

As I announced a couple weeks ago, the parish goal hasn't changed for many years. This year, however, we've been given the goal of \$151,562 (based on 3 yr. avg revenue), which is almost \$50k more than 187 families gave last year. As you can see, in order to reach our goal, it will take every family to do their part! Every gift matters, no matter how big or small, and each family is called to give what they can- in proportion to how God has blessed them. I personally have not given yet, but I plan to give this week. How about you?

If you have not done your part yet, can I ask- why not? I can imagine some of you have difficult situations, so are hesitant to give. However, please ask yourself, if your situation is more important or more critical than another's? Please keep in mind that a portion of the money raised in the CDA goes to help over 100 organizations, many of whom help the poor- those who don't have the money for even their basic needs. Your one-time gift could help another get by for months to come. In addition, giving what you can for the good of others instead of keeping it all for your own needs, shows God that you trust Him to help take care of your needs and desires.

During Lent, we are called to Pray more, Fast more, and Give Alms more. Giving to others in the CDA is giving Alms.

Have you discerned what you are going to do or give up in Lent this year? Consider this Scripture verse from the Book of Sirach, which was recently a reading for Daily Mass. (In fact, the whole book of Sirach, which we are going through in the first reading of daily Mass, offers great short statements to reflect on. Maybe that is something you are called to do each day?)

"Rely not on your wealth; say not: "I have the power".

Rely not on your strength in following the desires of your heart. Say not: "I have sinned, yet what has befallen me?" for the Most High bides his time.

Of forgiveness be not overconfident, adding sin upon sin. Say not: "Great is his mercy; my many sins he will forgive."

For mercy and anger alike are with him; upon the wicked alights his wrath.

Delay not your conversion to the LORD, put it not off from day to day." (Sirach 5: 1-8)

Let this Lent be about working toward a conversion. What area in your life is God calling you to grow closer to Him in? Or away from a certain Sin? Let what you do, or what you give up, work toward that area of conversion. And after Lent, don't plan to pick up the vice again, but continue to "Delay not your conversion to the Lord"!
