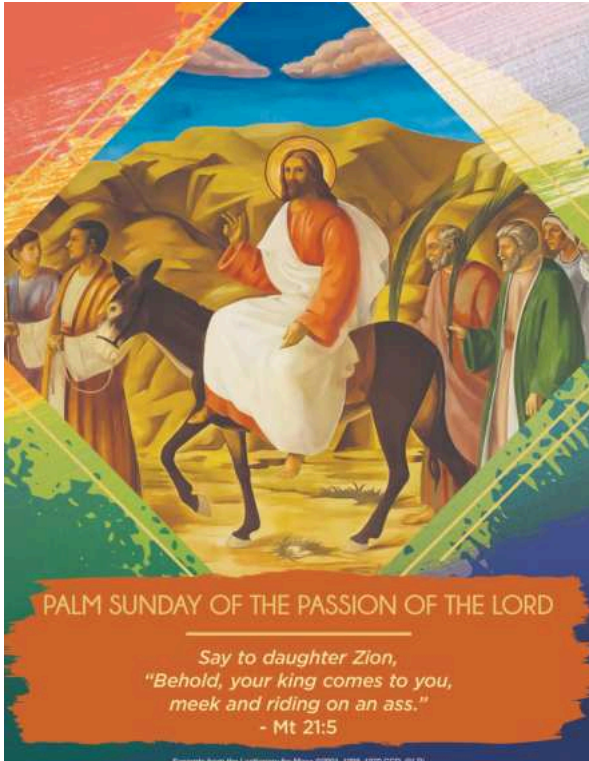

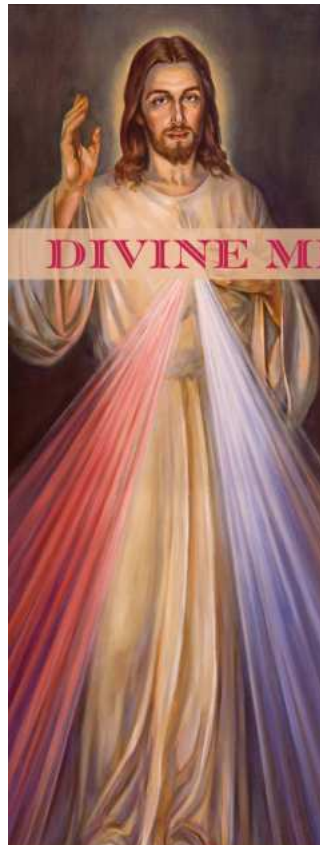

**WORKFORCE HOUSING'S FIRST RESIDENT MOVED INTO HER OWN PLACE & IS REBUILDING HER LIFE**



Carmela's life looked very different before St. Vincent de Paul's Rosalie's Place helped her secure housing and employment. Originally, Carmela was a hardworking caretaker who worked and rented a room in the same home. It seemed like a great situation at first before unhealthy patterns started to make life difficult. "Being home was scary," she said. "I was lost and scared." Eventually, things came to a head, and she lost her job and her housing in the same moment, which caused her to lose everything else she had built in her life. She felt like she had hit the lowest point in her life. Although her children supported her through everything, her struggle damaged her self-image, and she was ashamed to reach out to them for help.

Despite the dire circumstances, she got a job at a gas station and continued to work shifts while staying at a local shelter. While visiting the Phoenix Dining Room located at the downtown Key Campus, Carmela impressed the staff with her motivation to get a job that would help sustain permanent housing. The timing was perfect because SvDP was opening a workforce shelter. It turned out she was the perfect candidate for the shelter's first-ever resident, and she was able to move in not long after!

Carmela had the drive to get her life back, and Rosalie's Place gave her a safe place to do that. She had a stable bed that was hers for the duration of the stay, hygiene facilities, three meals every day, and workforce case management. Thanks to the program staff, she also learned how to build a successful resume and practiced interviewing with staff. She was even able to train and become a leasing agent and was also given a bike to make transportation to work easier.

"Rosalie's Place made me do a lot of soul-searching. I don't take things for granted anymore," she said. "If I can do it, anybody can do it."

When she found an apartment with utilities included that was only five minutes away from her new job at McDonald's, she felt like it was meant to be. Even better, she lives close to the light rail and bus system. Carmela's favorite part about her new place in life is her improved relationship with her two children. The stability of having consistent places to live and work makes it easier for her to spend time with her kids regularly. She feels good that she is in a place that makes them proud.

"My children are happy to hear where I'm at now," she said. Carmela is so grateful for her time at Rosalie's Place and SvDP that she wants to come back and volunteer her own time.

"Thank you so very much for what you've done for me. I'm in a lot better place," she said. "I want to keep helping others. I want to give back what they did for me."

# DARE TO BREAK THE JAR

## *Gospel Meditation*

March 29, 2026

**Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord  
Matthew 26:14-27:66**

Just prior to this week's Passion narrative in St. Matthew's Gospel, there is a small, striking story describing a woman's scandalous action toward Jesus: "A woman came up to him with an alabaster jar of costly perfumed oil, and poured it on his head" (Matthew 26:7). The ointment was pure nard, worth more than 300 denarii. A year's wages. Maybe a dowry, maybe a family inheritance. In any case, she breaks it. She does not measure or ration. She pours it all out, irreversibly, over Jesus. Why does this image begin Holy Week?

Because what she does with the jar, Jesus will soon do with his life. The jar must be broken so the fragrance can be released. Jesus' body will be broken so his priceless divine and human love can be poured out. She gives everything, just as he is about to give everything. And He sees it: "She has done a good thing for me" (Matthew 26:10). Her act is lavish, impractical, scandalous in its apparent wastefulness. And he loves it. It is what Holy Week is all about.

What jar are you still holding onto? Your time? Your comfort? Your plan for how life should go? Don't just wave palms today. Let yourself be broken open so your love, too, can be poured out.

***Lenten Challenge: Offer something costly to Jesus this Holy Week — not out of guilt, but love. Your attention. Your forgiveness. Your time. Break the jar. Trust that nothing poured out for him is ever wasted.***


