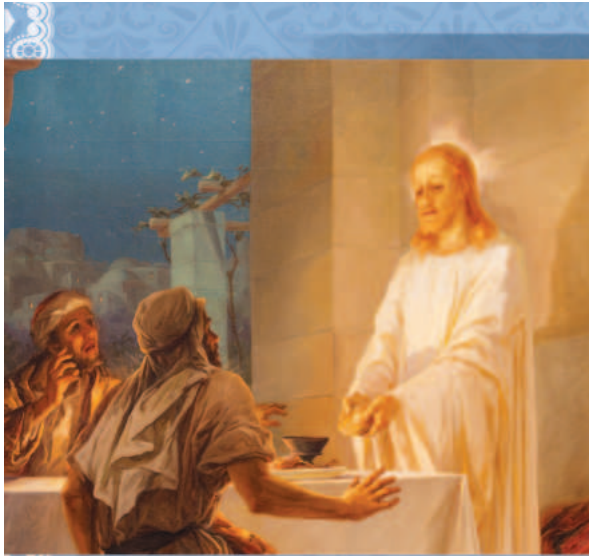

Little Flower Sacristan Ministry

The Little Flower Ministry is named in honor of St. Thérèse of Lisieux, Carmelite nun and Doctor of the Church, who served as a sacristan and who had a deep love for the Mass.

The Little Flower Ministry primarily serves in the preparation of the Sacred Liturgy. The attentive nature of women best serves the detail-oriented demands of the sacristy and preparations for Holy Mass. Their work echoes that of Our Lady who wrapped Jesus in swaddling clothes and all the ways she was attentive to the details of caring for Him as He grew up, her attentiveness to the shortage of wine at the wedding feast of Cana, and the women who prepared Jesus' body for burial with linens and spices.

The members make the preparations for Mass, preparing the sacred vessels, arranging the credence table, laying out the sacred vestments that will be worn by the priest and deacon, help distribute anything that needs to be distributed before Mass to the congregation, and bring up the gifts at the offertory. After Mass, they retrieve the vessels from the credence table and clean up. They may also assist in the training of altar servers.

Girls who serve in this ministry are also encouraged, not required to serve as Lectors.

The members of the Little Flower Ministry will have opportunities to come together to learn about the Sacred Liturgy, prayer, living the faith, the feminine genius and visit religious communities.

The Little Flower Ministry is open to all girls who have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation who have a desire to serve at Holy Mass.

St. Dominic Savio Altar Server Ministry

The St. Dominic Savio Altar Server Ministry is named in honor of St. Dominic Savio, the patron saint of altar servers. He became an altar server at age 5 and had an extraordinary love for God. "I want all I do, even the smallest thing, to be for the greater glory of God."

The Altar Server Ministry is a confraternity of boys and men who are dedicated to the service of the Altar of the Lord and have the privilege of assisting the priest for the celebration of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Service includes promoting the reverence and sacred nature of the Holy Mass while fostering discernment for vocations. Altar servers have many duties including leading the procession carrying the crucifix, candles and thurible (incense), holding the liturgical books, ringing the bells, and assisting in setting the altar.

Altar serving developed out of the temple servers of the Old Testament and is part of a noble tradition. "To serve at the altar... is next to the priesthood the highest privilege which a human can enjoy. He represents the faithful and takes a most intimate part in the rich treasures of the church's liturgy and ceremonial. Those sacred ceremonies should be carried out with devotion, dignity and attention to detail." ~ Bernard Cardinal Griffin of Westminster

The St. Dominic Savio Altar Server Ministry is open to all boys and men who have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist who have a desire to serve at the altar for the Holy Mass.

Gospel Meditation

April 19, 2026
3rd Sunday of Easter
Luke 24:13-3

When I first read Homer's *Odyssey* as a teenager, one scene captured my imagination: Odysseus finally returning home after 20 years, yet no one recognized him. Disguised as a beggar, he speaks with his wife, his son, and even his enemies. He is fully present, yet hidden. Only at the right moment does he reveal himself, and everyone realizes he has been with them all along. I was struck by the mystery that he could be so close to his loved ones, and yet they simply could not identify him.

A similar mystery is at the heart of today's Gospel. Two disciples walk the road to Emmaus with Jesus, but "their eyes were prevented from recognizing him." (Luke 24:16) He listens, teaches, and eats with them, yet they remain blind until he breaks the bread. Suddenly their eyes are opened — and at that very moment, he vanishes. His disappearance is not absence. Rather, it is revelation. The Risen Lord is now present in a new way, in the breaking of the bread and in the life of His Church.

Faith is this shift of vision. Instead of searching for a visible Jesus as if he were absent, we learn to recognize him unveiled in hidden ways — in Scripture proclaimed, in the Eucharist, in the sacraments, in the very life of the Church.

And what is true of him is true of us. Just as he disappears into the mission of his Body, we too are meant to be hidden in him. When we live hidden in Christ, we are seen for who we really are.
