First Saturday Devotion

The First Saturday Devotion Saves Souls

If you have not yet offered this devotion to Our Lady, consider beginning during the month of May.

May: Dedicated to Our Lady

This devotion began at the request of Our Lady of Fatima to Sr Lucia in 1925 for the conversion of sinners and peace in the world. We are in the 100th anniversary year of the devotion.

Its importance has not diminished. In fact, St Carlo Acutis shared a dream that he had shortly after the death of Sr Lucia. In the dream she told him, "The practice of the 5 First Saturdays of the month could change the destiny of the world." Wow! consider all the intentions you pray for - peace, health of self or others, return to the faith of your children or family members, and so many other intentions.

How to Make the First Saturday Devotion
offered in reparation for sins against the Immaculate Heart of Mary:

- Confession
- Holy Communion
- 5 Decade Rosary
- 15 Minute Meditation on the other mysteries of the Rosary

Legion of Mary leads this devotion each First Saturday beginning at 7:25 AM in the Chapel - Prayer guides are provided. Mass follows as well as opportunity for confession after Mass.

Little Flower Sacristan Ministry

The Little Flower Ministry is named in honor of St. Thérèse of Lisieux, Carmelite nun and Doctor of the Church, who served as a sacristan and who had a deep love for the Mass.

The Little Flower Ministry primarily serves in the preparation of the Sacred Liturgy. The attentive nature of women best serves the detail-oriented demands of the sacristy and preparations for Holy Mass. Their work echoes that of Our Lady who wrapped Jesus in swaddling clothes and all the ways she was attentive to the details of caring for Him as He grew up, her attentiveness to the shortage of wine at the wedding feast of Cana, and the women who prepared Jesus' body for burial with linens and spices.

The members make the preparations for Mass, preparing the sacred vessels, arranging the credence table, laying out the sacred vestments that will be worn by the priest and deacon, help distribute anything that needs to be distributed before Mass to the congregation, and bring up the gifts at the offertory. After Mass, they retrieve the vessels from the credence table and clean up. They may also assist in the training of altar servers.

Girls who serve in this ministry are also encouraged, not required to serve as Lectors.

The members of the Little Flower Ministry will have opportunities to come together to learn about the Sacred Liturgy, prayer, living the faith, the feminine genius and visit religious communities.

The Little Flower Ministry is open to all girls who have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist & Confirmation who have a desire to serve at Holy Mass.



A Widow's Journey *Is Widowhood a Vocation?* by Deborah Sedillo Dugan

Who am I now? I was married for more than half my life. I was a wife for many years; married to a wonderful man, and now I am widowed. Redefining, redesigning and relearning how to do life without him. Who am I now? I am alone. Who am I now?

"I have called you by name, you are mine." Isaiah 43:1

We must have heard Jesus calling us by name. He has chosen us for a purpose, we know it. Trusting in God has been pinnacle through this widowhood journey. Is widowhood a vocation? We are single now, not married here on earth. As widows, we are dedicated to prayer and service to the church and to Christ, providing in a way, a life-affirming vocation to our parish. Scripture tells us that the widow and orphan shall be taken care of.

The St. Gabriel Widow Warriors Ministry is an active ministry with close to 25 members. It is a ministry no woman wants to be a part of, yet here we are, finding our way through grief, grace and growth. We've done the counseling, we've read the books, we've consoled each other, we've cried, and we have laughed. We are sensitive and compassionate to loss and we are here for each other and for others who have experienced loss. During the past six months, we have had five new widows in our parish, some have learned about this ministry and others have traveled from other parishes to be a part of this ministry.

As widows, we lean on our faith to get us through the grief that will remain with us for a lifetime. We learn to live with it. It never gets any better, it just gets different. The magnitude of loss can be so grave that it feels like we are literally drowning and then one day, we bob up and down treading water, and then another day we start kicking and splashing and maybe another day taking one stroke at a time, starting to swim. On any given day we could go back to drowning and treading water because grief is unpredictable, cruel and unforgiving. There are good days and bad but because of our faith and love for Jesus Christ, He has saved us. Collectively as a widow ministry, we are trying to find hope and healing while rebuilding and remembering our loved ones. We are Widow Warriors. This ministry has been transformational for all of us, and for some, it has been life changing. Some have found their way back to church and have renewed their faith one day at a time.

"Do [the Lord] am with you and will watch over you wherever you go." Genesis 28:15

Today, May 3rd is National Widows Day, a day to remember widows in our parish, honoring their strength while also highlighting their service and faithfulness to Jesus. Some members don't have any family here other than church family, some have moved to assisted living and some have moved away to be closer to family. Regardless of location, we support each other and are here for each other. This dynamic group of strong women are learning how to redefine themselves while giving it to God and putting trust in Him to guide us, love us and show us the way.

Who am I? I am widowed and my vocation is prayer and service to the church.

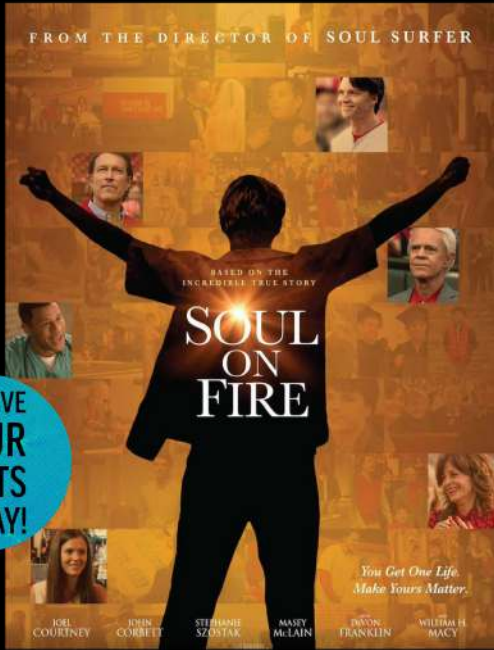

Gospel Meditation

May 3, 2026
5th Sunday of Easter
John 14:1-12

We generally approach life with the question, "What can this do for me?" We try a new workout, a low-carb diet, intermittent fasting, or a new career path, hoping it will make us healthier, stronger, happier. The assumption is that if I invest in this, I'll eventually reap some benefit, or I won't do it.

It is easy to think of faith the same way: if I really practice my faith, what will it do for me? Will it make me calmer, more moral, more successful?

But in today's Gospel, Jesus says something astonishing. He doesn't present himself as a teacher who shows us the way to life. He says, "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life." (John 14:6) He is not merely a guide toward some higher benefit. He is the benefit itself. To know him is to know Life.

Thomas Aquinas explains that every desire in the human heart — love, joy, meaning, all of our restless cravings — is really an indirect cry for life. Even despair testifies to this longing: people despair precisely because they feel they are not, and might never be, fully alive.

The good news is that Jesus is not simply the means to a better life; He is Life itself. To believe in him is to share in God's own eternal vitality. Not simply later but even now. Faith is not a transaction that produces results — it is a union that fills us with joy. To be in communion with Christ is to be truly, fully alive.

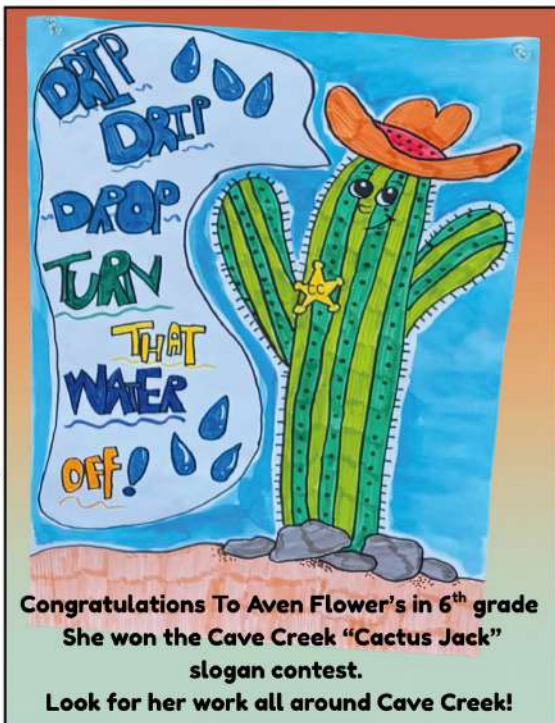
