### Photography & Videography Guidelines

At St. Gabriel's Church, a wedding is a sacred and religious event. To maintain the reverence of the ceremony, we ask all photographers and videographers to follow these guidelines:

**Attire:** Professional dress is required (e.g., dress, suit, coat). Jeans, t-shirts, and casual wear are not permitted.

**Equipment & Setup:**

- After setting up, please remove all storage cases and extraneous items from the church.
- Any damage to floors or furnishings from tripods or other equipment will be the responsibility of the photographer/videographer.

**Photography Restrictions:**

- Photographers may not enter the main aisle or sanctuary (altar area) during the ceremony.
- They must not block the entrance of the bridal party or guests.
- No flash photography is allowed before or during the ceremony.
- Equipment noise, including motor drives, must be kept to a minimum.

**Prohibited Items:**

- Drones, and/or similar devices are not allowed inside or outside the church.

**Time Restrictions:**

- All photography and videography inside the church must be completed within 30 minutes after the ceremony concludes.

**Videography Guidelines:**

- A maximum of two stationary cameras may be used during the ceremony. Placement must be coordinated in advance with the parish Wedding Coordinator.
- No cords or cables may be placed across any part of the floor.
- Any audio connections for the bride, groom, or presider must be wireless.
